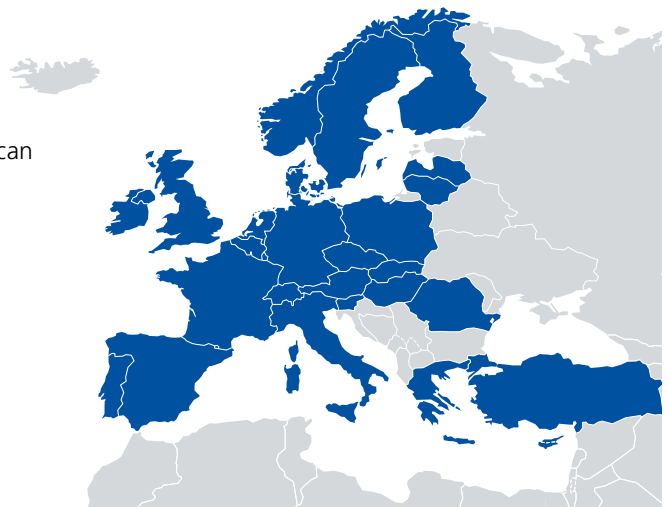

General Conditions

✓ Compliance with the collection terms

The collect customer ensures that the packaging made available for collection by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE complies with the following criteria. Should a packaging fail to meet one of the collection conditions, SCHÜTZ, its partners and its licensees are entitled to refuse to accept the packaging or subsequently to charge the collect customer for costs incurred.

✓ Reconditionable packaging types

> IBC

IBCs are collected free of charge by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE, provided the collection order is for IBC in the 1,000 litre version that can be reconditioned and that the general and regional terms and conditions are complied with.

> PE-Drum (Extended Conditions)

Open-head PE-Drums in the volumes from ≥ 30 l as well as tight-head PE-Drums in the volumes of ≥ 120 l in full truck loads are collected free of charge by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE, provided the collection order is for PE-Drums that can be reconditioned and that the general and regional terms and conditions are complied with.

> Steel drum (Extended Conditions)

Open-head steel drums and tight-head steel drums in the volumes of ≥ 200 l in full truck loads are collected free of charge by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE, provided the collection order is for steel drums that can be reconditioned and that the general and regional terms and conditions are complied with. Tight-head steel drums have to be according to DIN EN ISO 15750-2 with an UN-approval. Open-head steel drums have to be according to DIN EN ISO 15750-1. For both steel drum types the minimum material thickness for reconditioning is 0,8mm.

> Jerrycan (Extended Conditions)

Jerrycans with a capacity of at least 5 litres, which are palletized, stretch-wrapped and provided in full truck loads, are collected free of charge by the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE, provided that

- the collection order relates to jerrycans that are suitable for reconditioning, and
- the applicable general terms and conditions and regional collection conditions of the SCHÜTZ TICKET SERVICE are complied with.

For all the above specified packaging types special terms and conditions may apply to other models or filling volumes.

✓ Hazardous filling products

SCHÜTZ reserves the right to refuse to accept used packaging that poses a potential risk to health or environment. This includes in particular filling products with the H-statements H310, H330, H340, H350, H350i (USA: Mutagenic Cat. 1, Carcinogenic Cat. 1; Canada and Mexico: Toxic 6.1, Marine Pollutants [UN / 49CFR 172.101 appendix B]) and products which react heavily to water, if the packaging

has not been neutralized through appropriate measures. The neutralization process required must be described in detail by the collect customer in advance and requires prior written approval by SCHÜTZ. Neutralized packaging must be clearly and permanently marked as such in accordance with the instructions agreed with SCHÜTZ.

Additional country specific terms and conditions may apply.

✓ Undamaged packaging

All empty packaging units (IBCs, PE-drums, steel drums and jerrycans) made available for collection must be in a condition suitable for reconditioning. In particular, they must be free from significant damage (such as cracks, dents or deep scratches), excessive corrosion or oxidation, and all functional components must be intact.

✓ Completely emptied packaging

Every packaging unit must be completely empty and free of external product residues.

✓ Correct labelling and transport documents

Label plates, product labels and hazardous material labels have to be legible. Where appropriate, empty, uncleaned packaging must carry the same markings (UN number and name of the hazardous substance) and warning labels required by the valid hazardous goods regulations as full containers. Transport documents must comply with all appropriate regulations. The MSDS of the filling product must be provided on request.

✓ Closed packaging

Every packaging must be securely closed for transport with original discharge valves and / or other closure systems in place and operable.

✓ Correct quantities

The number of empty packaging units specified in the collection request must correspond to the actual number of packaging made available for collection. The minimum collection quantity applicable to the respective area is set out in the regional collection conditions.

✓ Legal regulations & liability

By placing a collection request, the collect customer automatically accepts the SCHÜTZ collection conditions and agrees to pay the costs incurred in case of non-compliance. The collect customer shall be liable for all manner of damage caused in connection with the handling – appropriate or otherwise – of packaging and its contents in preparation for their collection. All relevant national and international legislation and regulations must be complied with at all times.
